The society's long running Madison County Craft Festival has artisans, food trucks, live music, NYS wine and spirits, and free children's activities planned for an enjoyable family fun weekend. The society's Madison County Craft Festival Committee oversees the jurying process and meets monthly at closed meetings to review submissions. Past attendance has been between 3,000 - 3,200 people over the weekend. There is an admission of \$5 or \$8 for a weekend pass. Children 12 and under are free. **Deadline to apply: July 29, 2022.** Spaces may be available after the deadline date, please call the historical society. Proceeds from the Madison County Craft Festival support the educational programming at the Madison County Historical Society.

**Available Spaces:**

- This is an outdoor show. There are 16 tent spaces (10' wide x 7' deep) & 82 lawn spaces (12' x 12') available. For a lawn space, you must provide your own coverage/tent. For a tent space, we provide you coverage underneath one of our two tents. (Tables and electrical hookup are available for additional fees). Note that the Madison County Craft Festival Committee tries to satisfy all space requests; however, spaces are assigned in the order received. Artisans and Edible Art Vendors who have participated in the previous year's show can request a different space than the one assigned to them, provided that the Artisan or Edible Art Vendor, who may have also participated in the previous year, does not occupy that space.

**Jurying Criteria:**

- All work must be original and the work of the artisan. We are not accepting independent consultants at the Craft Festival.
- Only one artisan per application. Artisan partnerships are permitted. No more than two per application. Both must work on same products.
- Artisans and Edible Art Vendors may share a space, but the space must be clearly divided among the different products and no more than two per booth. Also, each must fill out separate applications.
- **Artisans (s) and Edible Art Vendor(s) are expected to create and sell only those items made by said artisan/vendor, and only items that pertain to the art/edible art for which said artisan/vendor is registered. No healing jewelry will be permitted in the show.**
- **History of show-**The Madison County Craft Festival dates back to May of 1964 when the historical society initiated a commitment to the preservation of traditional crafts by exhibiting agricultural implements and tools, once used for home crafts and cottage industries. This exhibit set the stage for the first Traditional Craft Days (former name), highlighting the skilled craftsmen and women whom demonstrated their artistry of the traditional methods creating works of art. On June 11, 1976, the New York State Legislature declared Oneida Craft Capital USA for the historical society's commitment to traditional crafts and the craftsmen and women whom demonstrated their artistry in the fields of shingle making, blacksmithing, pottery, quilting, spinning, woodworking and soap making. The Madison County Craft Festival Committee honors the traditions set forth in 1964, by selecting talented crafters through a jury process. In the past, we have encouraged artisans to demonstrate their craft in their booth for a couple of hours during the show. However, we realized this is difficult or impossible to do so. Therefore, we have decided that artisans are not required to demonstrate during the show. If an artisan would like to demonstrate, then we ask that the artisan let us know, so that we can advertise it. If an artisan would like to display a picture of him/her in his/her studio/workshop during the show, then please do so.
- Mass produced, buy and sell and items made from kits, patterns or molds are not allowed.
- Sewn items based upon the copyright or trademark of others (NFL, Disney, Warner Brothers, etc.) will be allowed. We recommend that the vendor complies with the necessary copyright laws.
- Prepackaged food vendors selling dips, jams, herbs, etc. must apply under the edible art category when filling out this form.
- No commercial apparel is allowed. Only original artwork designs that are screen printed are acceptable.
- Candles must be handcrafted.
- We are limiting the number of candle makers, soap and skin products, and jewelry in our show.
- Participants are required to participate both days.
- **You may apply online at our website, www.mchs1900.org where you must submit three (3) jpeg images of your work and one (1) of your booth display. If applying by mail, please provide these images on a disc or as separate pictures following the stated criteria with your application. Applications without the specified images will not be considered.** Please enclose a check for the booth space along with a separate check for the \$15 non-refundable jury fee. (Discs and photos will not be returned). Booth rates are listed on the application form. Notification letters will be mailed at or near the end of the month from November 2021– mid August 2022. Booth fees will be returned if you are not accepted into the show. *Any booth fees returned for insufficient funds for payment made by bank issued check must issue the historical society a money order for the original amount with an additional \$30 for the returned fee.* If you are accepted into the show and decide to drop out before August 1, 2022, a 50% refund will be issued. **No refunds will be issued after August 1, 2022.**

**Show set-up time/other: Friday, Sept. 9, 10 am - 6 pm. Arrangements can be made in advance for set-up at other hours. Coffee and donuts are served each morning to the vendors participating in the show. Check with show officials for location.**

**Event Hours: Saturday, September 10, from 10 am -5pm      &      Sunday, September 11, from 10 am -4 pm**

**Security: MCHS will provide security from 7 pm Friday - Saturday 7 am; Saturday 7 pm - Sunday 7 am.**

**Parking: Parking is available. Details will be provided once accepted.**

**Category Description for Madison County Craft Festival**

**Decorative Painting:** Tole painted objects; folk art, painted "found" objects- fabric or clothing items; stenciled or faux painted objects; painted wood or glass, lawn ornaments, figurines, or other hand-made wood items. **Fiber Arts & Leather:** garments and accessories- scarves, handbags, quilts, knits, crocheted or knit items, needlework, fabric, wool, weaving and tapestry, wool felted items- sculptures, leather, handmade paper items and baskets. **Floral Design:** bouquets, wreaths, garlands, or other arrangements or decorative objects that use dried press or silk florals. **Glass:** molded, slumped, fused, blown, or stained-glass items. **Jewelry:** beaded, sterling silver, gemstones, etc. **Metal:** furniture, sculpture, lawn ornaments, wall hangings. **Mixed/Other:** crafters who have more than one medium or items that do not fit into the categories. **Paintings, Drawings, and Frames:** Pencil, pastel, pen & ink, acrylic, oil, collage, mixed media or other works on canvas, glass and paper. **Photography**  
**Candles** **Skin Care Products** **Soap** **Pottery/Ceramics:** Sculpture or other items made from clay. **Toys and Dolls:** any medium must be handmade. **Woodworking:** Furniture and carvings. **Edible Art:** Vendors who make/produce food items such as fudge, chocolate, jams, sauces, dressings, spiced rubs, coffee, cookies, dried herbs, and wine. Repackaged wholesale items will not be accepted.
