The society's long-running Madison County Craft Festival has artisans, food trucks, live music, NYS wine and spirits, and free children's activities planned for an enjoyable family-fun weekend. The society's Madison County Craft Festival Committee oversees the jurying process and meets monthly at closed meetings to review submissions. Past attendance has been between 3,000 - 3,200 people over the weekend. There is an admission of \$5 or \$8 for a weekend pass. Children 12 and under are free. **Deadline to apply:** July 31, 2025. Spaces may be available after the deadline date, please call the historical society. Proceeds from the Madison County Craft Festival support the educational programming at the Madison County Historical Society.

#### **Available Spaces:**

• This is an outdoor show. There are 18 tent spaces (10' wide x 13' deep) & 82 lawn spaces (12' x 12') available. For a lawn space, you must provide your own coverage/tent. For a tent space, we provide you coverage underneath one of our two tents. (Tables and electrical hookup are available for additional fees). Note that the Madison County Craft Festival Committee tries to satisfy all space requests; however, spaces are assigned in the order received. Artisans and Edible Art Vendors who have participated in the previous year's show can request a different space than the one assigned to them, provided that the Artisan or Edible Art Vendor, who may have also participated in the previous year, does not occupy that space.

#### **Jurying Criteria:**

- All work must be original and the work of the artisan. We are not accepting independent consultants at the Craft Festival.
- Only one artisan per application. Artisan partnerships are permitted. No more than two per application. Both must work on the same products.
- Artisans and Edible Art Vendors may share a space, but the space must be clearly divided among the different products and no more than two per booth. Also, each must fill out separate applications.
- Artisans (s) and Edible Art Vendor(s) are expected to <u>create and sell only those items made by said artisan/vendor, and only items that pertain to the art/edible art for which said artisan/vendor is registered.</u> No healing jewelry will be permitted in the show.
- History of the show- The Madison County Craft Festival's early history began on May 22, 1965, when the Madison County Historical Society initiated a commitment to the preservation of traditional crafts by creating a Craft Show where they exhibited agricultural implements and tools, once used for home crafts and cottage industries. The exhibit set the stage for the first Traditional Craft Days (former name) in September 1965, highlighting the skilled craftsmen and women who demonstrated their artistry in the traditional methods of creating works of art. The Society furthered its involvement in folk art when it created a Traditional Craft Archive in 1971 complete with slides, tapes, movies, and periodicals documenting the traditional craftsmen and women. On June 11, 1976, the New York State Legislature declared Oneida Craft Capital USA for the Historical Society's commitment to traditional crafts and the craftsmen and women who demonstrated their artistry in the fields of shingle making, blacksmithing, pottery, quilting, spinning, woodworking, and soap making. In 2018, the 54th year of the show, the Madison County Craft Committee changed the event's name to the Madison County Craft Festival. The show features a wide selection of contemporary arts and crafts, ranging from functional to decorative works including fabric, glass, sculpture, ceramics, mixed media, metal, floral, drawings, paintings, jewelry photography, soap, skincare products, leather, and wood. The Madison County Craft Festival Committee selects talented artisans through a jury process. Each artisan must create and sell only items made by him/her. In the past, the Craft Festival Committee encouraged artisans to demonstrate their artistry in their booth for a couple of hours during the show. However, the Craft Festival Committee realized this is difficult or impossible to do, so it was decided that artisans are not required to demonstrate during the show. If an artisan would like to demonstrate, then we just ask that the artisan let us know, so tha
- Mass-produced, buy and sell, and items made from kits, patterns, or molds are not allowed.
- Sewn items based upon the copyright or trademark of others (NFL, Disney, Warner Brothers, etc.) will be allowed. We recommend that the vendor complies with the necessary copyright laws.
- · Prepackaged food vendors selling dips, jams, herbs, etc. must apply under the edible art category when filling out this form.
- No commercial apparel is allowed. Only original artwork designs that are screen printed are acceptable.
- Candles must be handcrafted.
- We are limiting the number of candle makers, soap and skin products, and jewelry in our show.
- Participants are required to participate on both days.
- You may apply online at our website, www.mchs1900.org where you must submit three (3) jpeg images of your work and one (1) of your booth display. If applying by mail, please provide these images on a disc or as separate pictures following the stated criteria with your application. Applications without the specified images will not be considered. You may pay by cash, check or by credit card. If paying by check, please enclose a check for the booth space along with a separate check for the \$15 non-refundable jury fee. (Discs and photos will not be returned). Booth rates are listed on the application form. Notification letters will be mailed at or near the end of the month from November 2025—mid-August 2025. Booth fees will be returned if you are not accepted into the show. Any booth fees returned for insufficient funds for payment made by bank-issued check must issue the historical society a money order for the original amount with an additional \$30 for the returned fee. If you are accepted into the show and decide to drop out before August 1, 2025, a 30% refund will be issued. No refunds will be issued after August 1, 2025.

Show set-up time/other: Friday, Sept. 5, 10 am - 6 pm. Arrangements can be made in advance for set-up at other hours. Coffee and donuts are served each morning to the vendors participating in the show. Check with show officials for location.

**Event Hours:** Saturday, September 6, from 10 am -5pm & Sunday, September 7, from 10 am -4 pm

Security: MCHS will provide security from 7 pm Friday - Saturday 7 am; Saturday 7 pm - Sunday 7 am.

Parking: NO Parking is allowed on the grounds. Parking is available on streets as well as a City of Oneida lot.
